

Canandaigua Rotary Club – Four Way Test Awards 2015 - 2016

Fellow Rotarians,

Since 1980, the Canandaigua Rotary Club has conducted its annual Awards program to highlight the recognition of those exemplifying qualities outlined in Rotary International's overview of things we say, think, or do; also known throughout the world as the Four Way Test, being: Is it the TRUTH?

Is it FAIR to all concerned?

Will it build GOOD WILL and BETTER FRIENDSHIPS?

Will it be BENEFICIAL to all concerned?

Canandaigua Rotary Club's Four Way Test awards are extended without age or gender limitations, to persons best representing five separate categories – Rotarian, Non Rotarian, Rookie Rotarian, Vocational, and Volunteer – who reside within the Greater Canandaigua Community. The awards have been traditionally described as ...

- Rotarian Award a Canandaigua Rotarian who best exemplifies the Four Way Test
- Non-Rotarian Award a non-Rotarian who best exemplifies the Four Way Test
- Vocational Award a Rotarian or non-Rotarian who contributes significantly to another person's educational and/or vocational progress
- Volunteer Award a non-Rotarian whose contribution of their individual personal time is their most worthwhile donation to our community
- Rookie Rotarian Award a Canandaigua Rotarian who has made a significant and worthy contribution of effort to Club activities during his/her first two years of membership.

Rotarian and Non-Rotarian awards began in 1980, Vocational in 1990, Volunteer in 2003, and Rookie in 2009, with recipients noted on reverse side. Those submitting a nominee for any of the five (5) awards are requested to follow those guidelines listed below as the <u>primary criteria</u> for all nominations, using ballot forms provided ...

- 1) What achievements were accomplished?
- 2) What responsibilities were undertaken?
- 3) Has personal integrity been paramount?
- 4) How did other persons benefit?
- 5) How did Rotary or other organizations benefit?
- 6) What leadership qualities were exercised?
- 7) What individual talents were contributed?
